

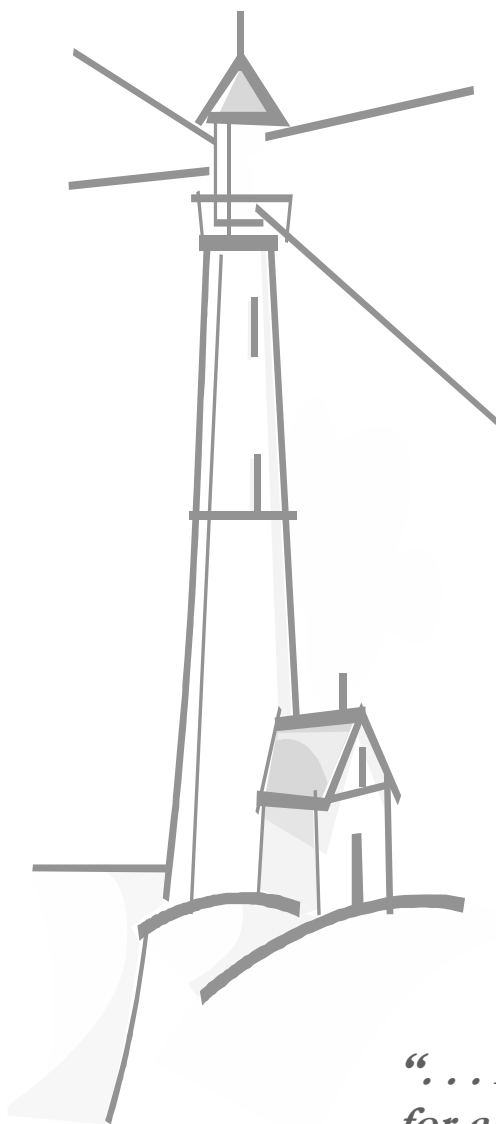

The Annual Christmas Mission Offering—

The Annual Christmas Mission offering will be received during the Advent season, concluding on Sunday, December 27th. This special offering is shared equally by two important mission concerns: Our Retired Ministers and Missionaries (RMMO) and our Region, the American Baptist Churches of Pennsylvania and Delaware (ABCOPAD). 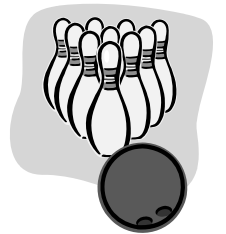
