

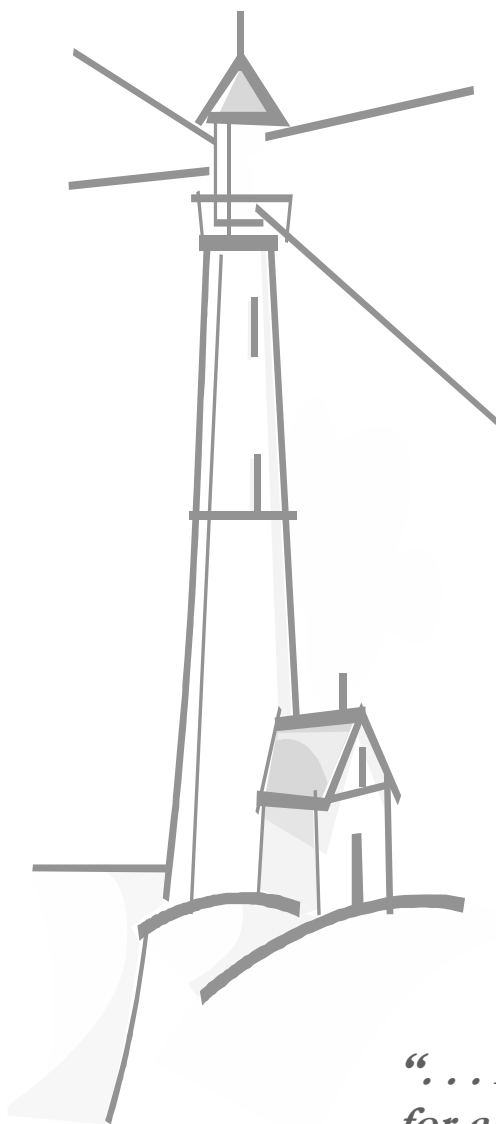

## Reflections on Today's Message

Our Sunday worship focus in February is on "Aspects of Love." How can we live out Christ-centered love with one another at church and at home? Paul's teaching in 1 Corinthians 13 indicates when love is alive and expressed. We'll explore five aspects of this kind of love today.

### When Love is Alive 1 Corinthians 13:4-8a

**1. Love is alive when it is \_\_\_\_\_.**

*"Love is patient..." (1 Corinthians 13:4a). "Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love" (Ephesians 4:2).*

**2. Love is alive when it \_\_\_\_\_.**

*"Love is kind..." (1 Corinthians 13:4b). ... "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you" (Ephesians 4:32).*

**3. Love is alive when it is \_\_\_\_\_.**

*"It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud" (1 Corinthians 13:4c).*

**4. Love is alive when it is \_\_\_\_\_.**

*"It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs" (1 Corinthians 13:5).*

**5. Love is alive when you put compassion into \_\_\_\_\_.**

*"It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres" (1 Corinthians 13:7).*
