Our poultry operations continue to supply the revenue stream necessary to run our mission. And we've increased the size from 4,000 every 6-7 weeks to 7,000. We'll grown to 10,000 in the coming year which will assist with operational cost of running the high school.



In 2018 we begin training leaders from other countries in how to use our mission as a model to expand into their countries and communities. Mean time we'll continue this journey to reach people who need to hear the Good News of Jesus, especially in areas where there is no technology nor access.
