Men's Bible Fellowship Group—

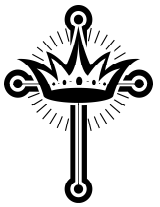

2018 Christian Service Enlistment Underway in November—



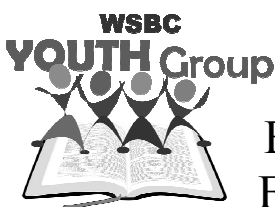
